INSTRUCTION FOR THE CANDIDATES.

- The departmental candidates will submit their applications through proper channel.
- Application form shall be downloaded from **NEEF** (National Examination & Evaluation Foundation) website i.e. (www.neef.org.pk) and may also be obtained from Railway Divisional Offices at Peshawar, Rawalpindi, Lahore, Multan Sukkur, Karachi, Quetta and Moghalpura.
- Eligibility of a candidate shall be determined on the basis of applicants qualification, performance in written test (to be conducted by **NEEF** i.e. National Examination & Evaluation Foundation), interview and criteria /policy devised by the department.
- Candidates shall submit application form duly filled in alongwith deposit slip /bank draft of rupees Rs.300/- in favor of M/S **NEEF**.
- Candidates are required to submit hard copy of the application form duly signed and filled, copy of CNIC and two fresh passport size photographs and self addressed dully stamped return envelope directly to **NEEF** through courier on the address mentioned on application form i.e. NEEF 1st floor Ch. Imtiaz Arcade, Square Commercial, Phase-7, Bahria Town, Rawalpindi.

6. Test fee shall be paid in any branch of United Bank Limited on prescribed Challan in favour of M/S NEEF. (bank challan is attached with application form)
7. Last date of submission of application is **04.04.2016**.
8. Incomplete application or application carrying incorrect information shall be summarily rejected. Only those candidates who have completed the requisite Diploma / Certificate are eligible to apply. Candidate to whom final transcript has not been issued shall not be considered.
9. Roll No. Slips containing the information regarding test centre, timings and test date shall be separately dispatched directly to candidates by **NEEF** at least one week before the test.
10. Candidates can also download their Roll No Slips, and papers content distribution from NEEF website later.
11. Candidates shall present original documents, alongwith a set of attested copies of all their relevant documents, at the time of interview.
12. For any updates, the website of **NEEF** may be visited regularly.
13. No TA/DA shall be admissible for/ interview.
14. The candidate selected will be required to:-
 - a. To pass prescribed Medical Examination.
 - b. To undergo specified training.
 - c. To join duty anywhere on the entire system of Pakistan Railways.
15. If any document revealed/ found bogus at any stage, the appointment will be treated as cancelled.
