- For item No. 3 and 4, only those applicants are eligible to apply on the basis of their domicile, who belong to Civil Districts and Tehsils of territorial jurisdiction of Lahore Division Certificate of domicile has to be provided by the applicant. - Applicants can apply for more than one posts as per qualification and eligibility requirements.

- For item No.3 to 4, only male candidates are eligible to apply.

**AGE LIMIT**

- 18-25 years + 5 years i.e. General Relaxation in upper age limit on ~~25~~ 08.2016.
- In case of EX-Servicemen, the upper age limit is relaxable to the extent of service rendered by the applicant in the Armed Forces or 15 years in addition to item No 1, whichever is less.
- The age of candidates belonging to the scheduled Castes, Buddhist Community, recognized Tribes of the Tribal Areas, Azad Kashmir, Northern Areas, Sindh/Rural & Balochistan is relaxed for 3 years in addition to item No.1 above.
- The age of Government servants and contract employees who have completed 2 years continuous Government service on the closing date for receipt of application is relaxed for 10 years in addition to item No.1 above.
- The age of sons of deceased Civil Servants who died during service is relaxed for 5 years in addition to item No.1 above.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATES

1. The departmental candidates will submit their applications through proper channel.
2. Application form + UBL deposit slip can be downloaded from internet by visiting NEEF (National Examination & Evaluation Foundation) website i.e. ([www.neef.org.pk](http://www.neef.org.pk)) after filling the biodata on the application form.
3. Application forms alongwith UBL deposit slip may also be obtained from Railway Divisional Offices at Peshawar, Rawalpindi, Lahore, Multan Sukkur, Karachi, Quetta and Moghalpura Divisions.
4. Test Fee shall be paid in any branch of United Bank Limited Bank on prescribed deposit slip downloaded from NEEF website or through demand draft of any bank payable at Islamabad in favour of M/S (NEEF). No application will be entertained in case the requisite fee as per instruction is not deposited. NEEF's copy of original deposit slip/demand draft must be attached with the hard copy the application form.
5. Eligibility of a candidate shall be determined on the basis of applicants' qualification, performance in written test (to be conducted by NEEF i.e. National Examination & Evaluation Foundation), interview and criteria /policy devised by the department.
6. Candidates shall submit application form duly filled in alongwith deposit slip/bank challan of UBL or demand draft of Rs.300/- in favour of M/S NEEF/Islamabad.
7. Candidates are required to submit hard copy of the application form duly signed and filled, deposit slip / bank draft copy of CNIC and two fresh passport size photographs and self-addressed duly stamped return envelope directly to NEEF through courier on the address mentioned on application form i.e.

8. Last date of submission of application is **25**08.2016.
9. Incomplete application or application carrying incorrect information shall be summarily rejected. Only those candidates who have completed the requisite Diploma / Certificate are eligible to apply. Candidate to whom final transcript has not been issued shall not be considered.
10. Roll No. Slips containing the information regarding test center, timings and test date shall be separately dispatched directly to candidates by NEEF at least one week before the test.
11. Candidates can also download their Roll No Slips, and paper content distribution from NEEF website later.
12. Candidates shall present original documents, i.e educational certificate, domicile CNIC etc alongwith a set of attested copies of all their relevant documents, at the time of interview.
13. For any updates, the website of NEEF may be visited regularly.
14. No TA/DA shall be admissible for/ interview.
15. The candidate selected will be required to:-
  - a. To pass prescribed Medical Examination and must be cleared by Security Agencies
  - b. To undergo specified training.
  - c. To join duty anywhere in respective Division of Pakistan Railways i.e. Peshawar, Rawalpindi, Lahore, Multan, Sukkur, Quetta & Karachi for item No 1 & 2 and Lahore Division only for item No. 3 & 4.
16. If any document revealed/ found bogus at any stage, the appointment will be treated as cancelled.
17. The following quota will also be observed:
  - a. 5% quota is fixed for Minorities/non-Muslims.
  - b. 5% quota is fixed for Orphans/destitute.
  - c. 2% quota is fixed for disabled persons for Item No.1& 2 only.
  - d. 10% quota is fixed for Ex-Servicemen.
  - e. 20% quota for son/daughter of Railways employees including 2% quota fixed for son/daughter of Railways deceased employees for Item No.3&4.
